WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING THIS WEEK?

PRESCHOOL

This week in Preschool, we learned the names of the sea animals. Then, in Phonics, we revisited the sounds we have learnt and words that begin with them. Finally, in Maths, we reviewed different ways to represent the numbers one to five.



This week in Reception we learnt the sound 'or' in phonics and wrote words and sentences with this sound. In Maths we learnt how to estimate and measure Weight. We continued learning about Healthy living and drew a picture of our healthy lunchbox.

Year 1

This week in Year 1, we have written fantastic letters to help characters find their missing belongings. We have rounded up our addition and subtraction unit by comparing statements. In Foundation, we have learnt about the 5 oceans and in Science we have compared seeds and bulbs.



This week for English we have written our own narrative stories about discovering an unusual creature. In Maths, we finished learning about 2D and 3D shapes - a topic we really enjoyed! We also concluded the results of our Science Investigation - What do plants need to grow well? The results were very interesting!



The children used their imaginations to pretend that they visited a natural wonder of the world. They used this to write a diary entry. In Maths, the children have been learning about unit and non-unit fractions. They thought of actions to help them remember all of the tricky vocabulary linked to this topic.





In Year 4, we completed the unit on length and measurement, where children can now convert from km to m and m to cm! In English, our pupils became authors and wrote their own twisted narrative based on 'Cinderella'. In Foundation, we celebrated the end of our topic with a wonderful Ancient Romans Day! We interviewed a Roman soldier, had a delicious banquet and made our own shields for battle.



In Year 5 this week, we have been editing, improving and completed our formal report. In Maths, we have been learning about decimals and percentages. We have been reading the final few chapters of our class novel 'Malamander' and in science we have been developing our understanding of the different life cycles of different animals.



In Year 6 this week, we have found pairs of values in Maths. In English, we completed our information texts about different animals. In Science, we performed a heart dissection. In Reading, we read the final few chapters of our class book, Letters from the Lighthouse. We also had a fantastic sports day on Monday!



Year 1: Has been learning to say and recognise farm animals.

Year 2: Has been learning about the sports using likes and dislikes.

Year 3: Has been learning about sports and hobbies using the verbs "Jugar and practicar".

Year 4: Has been learning about the free time activities using different types of verbs. Year 5: Has been learning to give an opinion about the school subjects and teachers using the agreements correctly.


Year 6: Has been learning remedies for ailments.
