WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING THIS WEEK?

PRESCHOOL

This week in Preschool, we learned the names of the different types of water transportation. Next, in Phonics, we discovered a new sound; the "b" sound and words that begin with it. Finally, in Maths, we learned different ways to represent the number 10.



This week in Reception we have been focusing on writing instructions on 'how to make a jam sandwich'. To conclude the topic we made jam sandwiches in class. In Maths we learnt the Days of the week and Months of the year and answered questions using the key words: before,after, next, first, last, yesterday,today,tomorrow. We read the story 'The Hungry Caterpillar' to help us with the days of the week.

Year 1

Year 1 have been using repeated addition and adding equal groups, in Maths. In English, they have been exploring the example text 'Black Rock' by using hot seating, drama and freeze frames. In Foundation, Year 1 have been looking at the materials used to make flags. This has influenced their design process.



This week in Year 2 we have continued looking at time for Maths. In English, we have been looking at the story of Rosie Revere- Engineer. We also further explored the example text. In Foundation, we started a new topic all about Puppets! In Science, we looked at what animals need in order to survive.



This week, Year 3 have been writing an information leaflet about rainforests. In Maths, they have been learning about measuring and calculating length and perimeter. In Science, they looked at pollination and seed dispersal in detail. They made up actions to help them remember the difficult vocabulary words.





In Year 4, we have been absolutely outstanding with our decimals work! Children are able to order and compare a variety of decimals confidently and independently. In English, we have been creating our own setting poems based on the sea. In Foundation, we created a facebook page for Jacques Cousteau focusing on his key interests and events in his life!



This week, Year 5 has been analysing and learning about the features of a survival guide; we introduced our new topic with a series of exciting puzzles in English. In maths, we have concluded our learning on shape and we are now beginning to learn about coordinates, position and direction. In science, we have learned about the human timeline and different stages of life.



This week in Year 6, we have been calculating the interior angles inside a triangle. In English, we have been using drama to describe a scene from our new book. In Science, we have been identifying the habitats of different animals and their adaptive traits. Lastly, in Foundation, we have been learning about the beliefs of the Ancient Greeks!



Year 1: Has been learning to write basic description about the parts of the body using singular and plural

Year 2: Has been learning to describe the animal park using numbers, singular and plural.

Year 3: Has been learning to describe pets.

Year 4: Has been learning to describe the character using the verb Ser.

Year 5: Has been learning to describe their bedroom.

Year 6: Has been learning the parts of the city.
















Information
