Dear parents,

Our new academic year will resume next week, on Sunday August 21, and we are all very much looking forward to seeing our brilliant students once again. As noted previously, lessons will begin promptly at 07.00 and I would be grateful if parents could ensure that students in all year groups arrive punctually each day and are collected on time at 13.30. In addition, I would once again urge parents and drivers to be both mindful of road safety when transporting the young people of our community and to show consideration for not only road users but also pedestrians when parking their vehicles near our school. Earlier this week, parents were also reminded that they are required to wear ID lanyards when entering our school site, for safeguarding reasons. If parents could ensure that they have their ID lanyards ready for next week, that would be hugely appreciated.

I would remind parents that all students are required to submit the results of a negative antigen test before they can be granted admission to our school site on Sunday. Test results are to be logged via <u>this online form</u>.

Another change this year is our school uniform. Students may continue to wear our old DBS uniform during the two-year phasing in period, but details of the new uniform, which is the only version parents will be able to buy from our supplier, are available <u>here</u>.

Finally, we will remain as committed as ever this year to making sure that communication between home and school is as effective as possible. To this end, parents can access the school email addresses of all teachers <u>here</u>. Wherever possible, teachers will communicate swiftly with parents should questions be asked, although I would ask our community to only send or schedule emails to take place during normal working hours. In primary, the preferred means of communication between home and school will continue to be via Class Dojo.
