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What are ECAs?

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Extra Curricular Activities are held after school by our highly qualified teachers and other professionals.

There is a wide range of activities provided for your child to improve their skills and discover new talents. This enables our students to excel beyond their academic studies. It will be available for children from Year 1 to Year 11.

ECAs will begin on the **week beginning 18th September** and will run until the end of the **week beginning 6th November**. ECAs will be held on the following days: Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from **1:45pm to 2:30pm**. If you are late to collect your child more than two times, your child will be removed from the ECA.

There will be a maximum of 15-20 children in each ECA.

Please click and choose the preferred ECA for your child and it will be offered on a first come first served basis. For your reference:

- children in KS1 are Years 1 and 2
- children in KS2 are Years 3-6
- secondary students are Years 7-11.

The final day to sign up will be the end of day on Tuesday 13th September. Afterwards, we will communicate to you which ECA your child will take part in.

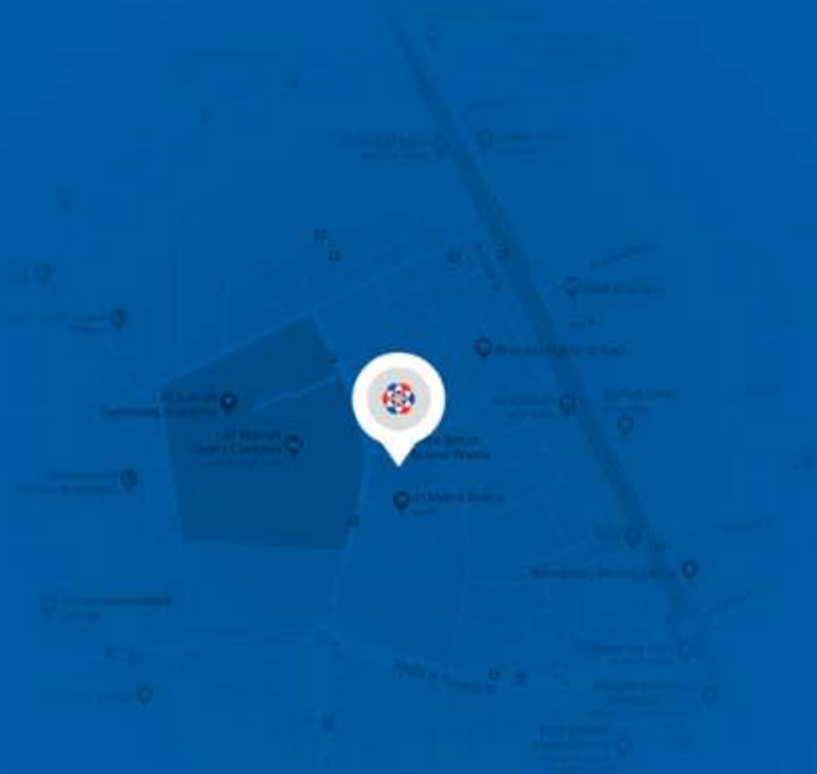
Remember to only choose an ECA for the Key Stage / Year Group your child is in. If you have more than one child, you will need to complete the form for each child.
