Also, they completed their hot task in English and we are very proud of their progress.In Foundation, they joined 2 pieces of material together using a needle and thread. We also completed research and fact files on all the countries competing in the World Cup. Furthermore, we designed new football kits for each team. In English, we published our third person character narratives! In Maths, we converted between mixed numbers and improper fractions and we compared fractions.



Year 6 have gone World Cup crazy this week! We started by researching about a country of our choice and creating a fact file. We also created a poster on Spain and Portugal and designed a new football kit for them, as well as drew significant Spanish and Portuguese landmarks. In English, we published our flashback narratives! In Design and Technology, we designed and made sandwiches for our refugee survival kits!


These children have had their birthday this week
