WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING THIS WEEK?

PRESCHOOL

Preschool had a very busy week. We learned a new Nursery Rhyme, Humpty Dumpty. We role played the sequence of the rhyme. We thoroughly enjoyed exploring the tuff tray. In Phonics, we continued to learn that we can use our body parts to play the beat of a song and create a new generic beat to a song. In maths, we revisited how to make a set using different objects: for example, buttons, colours, shapes and sizes. Reception

What a great week of diving into our learning! We have been learning to tell our own stories with a beginning, middle and end. We have been learning about the number 0 in maths. In phonics, we learnt the sounds 'u' and 'r' and our tricky word 'into'. We have been doing lots of fine motor activities to help our little hands!

Year 1

Year 1 have been very busy Bats and Butterflies this week! In English, we used our sentence snakes to help us write FANTASTIC sentences all about Juniper Jupiter! We challenged ourselves in Maths to apply our knowledge to answer addition problems, although this was very tricky Year 1 showed great resilience! We went further into our toy topic and created our very own spinning tops or thaumatropes. Lastly, our little scientists also identified and describe the different objects in our classroom.

YEAR 2

Year Two have had an amazing week of learning. In Art, we have developed our observation skills by sketching animals. We have delved deeper into our new text in English by learning new and interesting vocabulary. We have utilised our addition and subtraction skills, solving complex calculations!

Year 3

Year 3 have had a great week, in English we have been exploring our new Non-Fiction text, The Fox. In maths, we began looking at the column method which all the children grasped and understood fantastically! During our science lesson, we have been learning all about food waste and to top it all off in reading we had our own class debate! In Art, we have continued to explore Cave Art using chalk, charcoal and paint. WELL- DONE year 3!

Year 4

In Year 4, we have had an incredible start to our character description writing in English. We have really pushed ourselves to use descriptive phrases and adding in prepositions to add further detail. In Maths, we have been superstars with our 3 and 6 times tables. We've applied our knowledge to different games to help consolidate our learning. During our Science lessons this week, we found ourselves portrating particles within a solid, liquid and gas!



Year 5

A super busy and fun week in Year 5! We have enjoyed learning how to use Canva to create our very own planet fact files. We have learnt all about square and cube numbers. A highlight of the week was debating about whether we should send people to Space - there were certainly some interesting points shared. Next week, we will multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1,000, concluding our maths unit with an assessment.

YEAR 6


This week we have enjoyed lots of practical work! We have been learning about electrical circuits to light bulbs and using atlases in Foundation to compare the populations of European countries pre and post WWII. In English we created setting descriptions whilst trying to include as many figurative language techniques as we could. Learning about how to multiply fractions and add/subtract mixed numbers in Maths has really helped us in our Arithmetic assessments too!

We were learning musical notation, musical elements, instruments of the orchestra (the string and brass family) , listening to the sound of the instruments and trying to understand the difference. Students have been practising singing different melodies with SolFa hand signs. We have also sung a variety of songs such as 'Hello Song', 'Good morning song', 'Snap', 'Pete cat', 'Diamonds'.


