WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING THIS WEEK?

PRESCHOOL

It was a creepy crawly week with all the Minibeasts around us, but the Preschoolers were so brave in exploring and learning about them. With the Minibeasts came along Number 4, and the preschoolers loved connecting their knowledge to 4 dots on the Ladybird and their 4 legs. During our phonics lessons we explored the letter and sound 't', we encouraged children to identify words beginning with 't' and focused on pronunciation. Next week will be a deep dive into the ocean!



Another amazing week flew by for Tigers and Koalas! In Phonics we moved on to diagraphs: sh, ch, qu. In Maths we explored with numbers 9,10. The highlight of the past days was our amazing Kidzania adventure! It was such great fun to practice our social skills by being postmen, policemen, flight captains, doctors and shop workers. We learned many things about these jobs, which we are sure it will come to a great use when we are older. We are already looking forward to our next adventure together!



Wow, this week has been a blast! In English we became detectives to help solve Mrs Johnston's mystery of her lost Batman toothbrush! Our mathematicians have now completed their Place Value within 20 unit and have gained a strong and secure understanding! We also LOVED having our parents in our Maths lesson to showcase our learning. In Science, we continued to classify a range of animals and learned the characteristics of amphibians and reptiles. Well done Bats and Butterflies!



Year Two have had a very rewarding week of learning. In English, we started our week learning about past and present tense verbs, and time adverbials. In maths, we challenged ourselves by learning different methods of finding change. We had a reflective Design and Technology lesson by evaluating our finished hanging decoration. We are very proud of the knowledge and skills we have acquired in science and we completed our plant topic assessment. What a fantastic week of learning we have had!



Another amazing week in Year 3! We started a new topic in Science which is soils. We used different resources to investigate some soils and learnt about it's qualities. We also started our new topic in maths of length. We have been measuring lots of things in the classroom. Including who can jump the furthest (which was a fantastic 1m45cm). In Foundation we have been continuing to learn about chocolate, we discovered where it is grown and created our own diary entries all about it. Well done Year 3!





Wow what a week year 4 has had from writing non-chronological reports on penguins to scientific experiments on decibels. In English we have been scientific explorers and researched facts on penguins to use in our shared write. In maths, we came to the end of a fun topic in multiplication and division and we are so impressed with the progress the children have made. During our Roman topic this week we took to the central area and learned about what life was like as a Roman soldier. We had so much fun performing different fighting formations with our shields whilst Mr Cooper threw arrows at us.

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Year 5 has had an exciting week! In Maths, we have worked on the area model and column method for multiplying. They enjoyed sharing this knowledge with the parents on Tuesday. In English, we have been creating our tool kit for our biographies and started planning our Class Write. In Science, the children have been planning a thermal insulator investigation and wrote up their findings.



Year 6 have been hard at work this week! We began our new Maths topic of Algebra, learning algebraic expressions and using function machines. In English, we created our own toolkit of features to help us with our class and independent writes on Information Texts. In Foundation, we learned about the impact of hate groups during the Civil Rights Movement and analysed the UDHR. Well done everyone!



Year 1: Has been learning to say and write the numbers to 20.

Year 2: Has been learning to write affirmative and negative sentences using basic connectives.

Year 3: Has been learning to describe others according to masculine and feminine. Year 4: Has been learning to use the question words.

Year 5: Has been learning to describe what they have in their school bag.

Year 6: Has been learning to say what they eat for breakfast, lunch and dinner.



This week Primary students have been playing Hello game, High and low game, body percussion beats, percussion instruments. We were learning musical notation, and musical elements. Students have been practising singing different melodies with SolFa hand signs. Watched musical stories, discussed characters and instruments, and listened to character themes individually. Students practised "Rhythm in the way we walk" "Please and thank you", "Do re mi", "Good morning song".

Primary pupils can wear PE uniforms, including T-Shirts in their house colours all week.


Water Sports:
