

"It has been a long time since I have reflected on my journey from DBS to Leicester and I have to say that it was truly an experience transitioning from the Middle East back to the United Kingdom. I actually took a gap year as I was unsatisfied with the offer I already had on the table. Because of that, myself and my family decided to permanently move back to Ireland, where I was born, in order for me to prepare for the next application cycle. Fast forward 2 years later and I am currently in my 2nd year studying medicine at the University of Leicester doing what I've always wanted to do.

Whilst I am not working in the healthcare sector, I did train to become a Healthcare Assistant for the NHS but have not yet decided if I want to spend time working shifts. Throughout my time in medical school, I have been acquiring more in-depth knowledge of the human anatomy, the clinical aspect of medicine, as well as the necessary holistic skills to be a better doctor. Furthermore, I have enjoyed learning and practising my research skills in the scope of medicine which I am currently trying to pursue to participate in research programs as well as audits. Outside of that, I have been developing my programming skills with regards to 'lua' whilst working on a game with some of my friends.

I am happy to say that my first year in medicine was fruitful, as I had managed to achieve a Distinction certificate for scoring in the top 10% in my class. Unfortunately, I was not able to participate in a research study that I had been waiting to do for a long time due to extenuating circumstances. However, I am adamant in trying to make the most out of this year so that I can fully explore career paths that I may wish to pursue further down the line after medical school. What I found upon reflection of my time in secondary school was that DBS helped shape my passion for medicine, as well as an interest in research with the IB program. Some of my first moments learning about referencing and writing higher level essays was at DBS, and it most definitely assisted in my further development of those skills at Leicester.

Some words of advice for those wishing to pursue medicine is not to take it lightly. This is NOT something that I am interested in doing because of money and neither should you. Medicine is a responsibility to treat those in your community to the best of your abilities in order to support them through difficult moments in their life. It is also about helping your colleagues in the development of our understanding of how we treat patients through research and rigorous study. It is a lifelong profession, which makes it a part of you. I wish you all the best of luck in your future careers wherever they may take you, and I hope that DBS is helping with that journey."
